Training & tools

- How was the ECCOREV R training? There were very different levels.
 We need more basic training, from the very very beginning for PhDs.
- R training still needed (no matter whether course or individual).
- Training in TROPES (open source, large data, survey assessment), ENVIVO wished.
- Data catalog: potential conflicts with cooperation partners and property rights need to be clarified.
- Map templates. Has it been done? It is finished(Sinan), can be used soon, if needed.
- The new members did not know about the format, logo etc for presentations and the sentences for putting in the publications.
 Please provide template etc in the internet site.

OT-Med integration & identity

- General feeling of progress in scientific functioning.
- Difficult to feel that we are OT MED, especially when you are not in Arbois. But not only because of that, it is that we are more connected to our labs. But maybe that is ok.
- Maybe the labs could have informal OTMED events, like having lunch, once in a while.
- The feeling of being OTMED is strong in work package meetings. Maybe more of this but well planed (with an aim, with milestones, etc). Should be dynamic and leaders should communicate for what we are meeting. Max 2 per year though.
- Sometimes the fact that PhD supervisors are not active in OTMED makes the integration in OTMED difficult.
- OTMED good for meeting other people and connect, even within our labs.
- In our internet page links to our presentations in conferences etc (intranet not open to increase collaboration within otmed)
- It would be nice to be able to add things in our otmed internet (links to our personal web page (labs) or link to professional profiles, etc.). Can we have the possibility of editing that?
- Use researchgate recommended. Maybe someone should make an OTMED group there
- Recommendation for next year progress meeting: we need feedback on our presentations! So we can learn.

OT-Med administration & formalities

- Already clearer than last year, but:
- Lacking communication between Ecole Doctoral AMU and OT Med, very difficult to deal with formalities. Whole days filling forms, not clear what form, and repeating the process every year.
- Not enough information about ADOM, what that is, for what?
- Kind of tiring to send emails with questions to administration ladies. A
 HowToDo document with all informations would be good. And more help
 from every Lab in clarifying administration.
- Provide a list of who to contact for which ecole doctorale, because we can
 not always help each other since we belong to different Ecole Doctorale
- Who signs the form for going to field work? Not clear at all, it is apparently the university but we have been doing by the labs. More clarification, insurance is needed so we have to do that right. Clarify what to do if travel is not in France. It is complicated because it depends on who funds the travel. More and clear information in the web site of Otmed would help.

Events

- WHAT ARE YOUR NEW SUGGESTIONS CONCERNING OT-MED EVENTS? (formal and informal)
- Would you to have more common events (like this meeting, the modelling workshop, the PhD and postdocs meeting)? What kind of events?
- Some express that they have too much to do to go to events.

 months or so for increase communication both with other packages
 and only with people of the WP for increasing cooperation. Sort of
 peer review process for young scientists in those meeting.
- Non scientific trainings and events would be nice (soft skills, presentation techniques, what to do in our future after the PhD, how to jump to the private sector, etc.)

International mobility

- Did you have the possibility to participate in all the international events that you wanted?
- Positive experiences in general, we thank for the support.
- But more motivation for young PhDs to go out to conferences. Encourage them somehow, even at the beginning. Take the initiative.
